



Calling all Photographers!

Heritage Photography Opportunity in St Mary de Crypt Church and the Old Crypt Schoolroom, Gloucester

The Discover DeCrypt project has received Heritage Lottery Funding to transform St Mary de Crypt Church and the Old Crypt Schoolroom, Southgate Street, Gloucester from historic buildings in danger of decay and dilapidation into a sustainable heritage attraction, educational resource, working church, cultural venue and community facility in the heart of Gloucester, open and available to all. Capital works will take place in 2018 to install modern facilities while carefully preserving and maintaining the valuable fabric and fittings of these historic buildings.

The church is now closed to the public until March 2019, but before the building work starts in January we want to create a comprehensive photographic record of the buildings as they currently stand, so that all changes, however small, can be traced. We will therefore be **opening up the buildings to photographers on Thursday 19 Oct 2.00 – 4.00pm and Saturday 21 Oct 10.30am -12noon**. This is an exciting opportunity for all photographers, both amateur and professional, with an interest in heritage, churches or architecture to enjoy free access to these special buildings. Please note that the lighting in the building is poor, especially in the evening. There will be scaffolding up around most of the buildings, so opportunities for outside photography will be limited.

The Discover DeCrypt project will keep the right to use any photos from these events, but will acknowledge copyright of the photographers.
